Secretary's report pursuant to G.L. Statues 12.050

Auburn-Grass Valley Lodge #538

Started April 1, 2023-2024 Lodge year with 558 members. As of March 31, 2023, we have initiated 34, affiliated by dimit 70 and reinstated 8.

Stricken from the rolls for non-payment 28, granted transfer dimits 11, granted absolute dimits 14, and 27 members died during the year. This gives us a membership of 588, a gain for the year of 30.

As of April 12, 2023, we received for the 2023-2024 Lodge year.

The Lodge received for the 2023-2024 year: Dues \$66,540, initiation fees \$300, and affiliation fees \$50. The following donations were received with the Lodge dues: Major Project \$1,585, Elks National Foundation \$1,120, and the Lodge Improvement Fund \$2,350.

Auburn-Grass Valley Elks Lodge #538 per capita assessments for Lodge year 2023-2024 California-Hawaii Elks Association \$3,528.00, Grand Lodge \$17,052.00, and Northeast District \$2,352. For a total per-capita assessment of \$22,932.00.

There are 6 candidates pending initiation, 0 pending transfers in, and 1 pending transfer out.

Member **Clarence Bothello** passed away on July 17, 2022. A Celebration of Life for long time member, **Ron LeDoux**, was recently held at the Lodge.


