



Veterans Corner

Happy New Year, 2024. Sure hope your 2023 ended on a high note. With this new year comes the opportunity to up your game (involvement in our Elks Lodge). A good resolution would be to become more involved in the Lodge events. Maybe volunteer some time. Pat Hall needs all the help she can muster. Ending last year was great for our Veterans Committee. The financial support ya'll gave us towards the Veterans luncheon was greatly appreciated. God bless all of you who donated. We'll coast into our new year with a big smile and a head start on the BBQ we provide to the Veterans at the Reno VA Hospital. I tried to recall everyone's name who donated to our cause and mentioned their names in the December Bulletin. If I forgot someone, I apologize sincerely. Your hearts are in the right place. Thank you.

Now that it is January, we, the Veterans Committee, can take a short break before planning the May return to the Reno VA hospital. I need a break. Last year at the VA hospital there was a significant change in the protocols regarding the food for the patients. As it stands now, it will significantly decrease our costs, yet we'll be serving the same meal again this year.

There were many dates to remember in past Januarys, so here are a few. January 8, 1815, the Battle of New Orleans was the last battle of the War of 1812; December 17, 1991, Operation Desert Storm began; January 21, 1903, was the birth of the modern National Guard; January 25, 1945, the Ardennes-Alsace Campaign (Battle of the Bulge) ends; January 28, 1973, Vietnam Cease-Fire Campaign ended; January 30, 1968, the Tet Offensive began in South Vietnam; and January 31, 1990, Operation Just Cause ended. The Tet Offensive was important to me as I was stationed at the Presidio of San Francisco when about March of that year I received orders to report to a unit in Saigon (out of my skill set). Orders for people in my job came from a specific office in the Pentagon. These orders did not come from that office. Four days later, I was off orders for that deployment. I had a younger brother already serving in Da Nang, South Viet Nam. Two months later I received my orders to report to my CID unit in Seoul, South Korea, the guiet war that was being reported on the back of the front section of our nation's newspapers. I finished my tour of service at that unit. Life went on.

As this edition concludes, let us all not forget our brothers in arms around the world. Whatever their condition is, healthy or injured, keep them in your hearts and prayers. Pray for their safe return to their families. Remember to put in a good word for your family and friends as you say your evening prayers from the comfort of your recliner in the living room near the fireplace with the television on your favorite show. God is listening. God Bless America.

Auburn – Grass Valley Elks Lodge 538 Scholarships for 2023-2024

This year there are two scholarships for seniors graduating in the Spring of 2024. The scholarship applications will be available beginning October 12, 2023.

WIL THOMAS EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

This is the fifth year of the Wil Thomas Educational Scholarship. This scholarship's value is \$1000.00 and is for family members of past or present members of the Auburn – Grass Valley Elks Lodge 538. It is offered to seniors who plan to attend a university, college, or vocational school in the Fall of 2024.

CLIFFORD LOOBY SCHOLARSHIP

This is the 18th year that the Looby Scholarship has been offered to graduating seniors planning to attend a university or college in the Fall of 2023. The value of this scholarship is \$1250.00. The senior must be a child, stepchild, or grandchild of an active Elk in Auburn – Grass Valley Lodge 538. Previous winners of this scholarship have graduated from high schools in California (last year), Nevada, Oregon, and Washington.
