



VETERANS CORNER

April is here! Spring weather, warm days, and evenings await us all. Enjoy all that this Spring blesses you with. At our house, we have already had several BBQs.

Have you paid your annual dues?

The Placer Veterans Stand Down will run May 6 through May 9, 2024, at Roseville's Grounds (formerly the Placer County Fairgrounds). This FREE event is for all U.S. military veterans and their families (Gates open at 8 am daily). Veteran ID required: DD214, VA Card, etc.

Free services will include dental, medical, vision, DMV (legal services and child support for Placer County residents), employment counseling and housing referral, VA benefits assistance, PTSD counseling and assistance, pet services: veterinarian staff (vaccinations and supplies), clothing and personal care supplies, meals and optional overnight accommodations, haircuts, and showers; Health & Human Services Assistance, Integrative Health Services. You may check in on Monday, May 6, from 3 to 7 pm. Stay for dinner and spend the night, then you're ready to begin services on Tuesday at 8 am. For dental, hearing, vision, and legal services, you must pre-register by calling (916) 251-9249.

On May 11, 2024, we will drive to the Reno Veterans Hospital for our annual BBQ luncheon. At present, the residence facility is at capacity (60 patients). We'll BBQ hamburgers and hot dogs with all the fixins, including soda and cake. Would you like to join us and help serve all these deserving veterans? If so, be at the Lodge at 9 am sharp or earlier so we can carpool.

We need to be there with enough time to set up everything. This is a group effort as we also feed the staff and our volunteers.

There are several dates this month that are worthy of your notice. April 1 is April Fool's Day; April 6, 1917, the U.S. entered World War 1; April 9, 1987, the Special Forces became a separate branch of the Army; April 15 is Tax Day; April 22 is Earth Day; April 25, 1898, the U.S. declares war on Spain; April 26 is Arbor Day; April 28, 1952, Occupation of Japan ends; April 28, 1965, U.S. forces invade the Dominican Republic (Operation Power Pack); April 29, 1970, U.S. forces invade Cambodia.

Let us not forget that we continue to have military personnel serving all around the world, in some cases in lands hostile to our country. We have freedom of movement and the right to speak out. They do not! Say a prayer for all our military. Include your family and friends. You can say a brief prayer while sitting in your easy chair watching the news or whatever interests you. God hears you. God Bless America.
