## Veterans Corner

June is busting out all over. The weather has had a significant change for us. The long pants are coming off, and shorts are replacing them. It is now summer. Our trip to the Reno VA Hospital is behind us. Now to recap. I apologize for setting the date for our trip on the day before Mother's Day, May 13th. That was a mistake on my part. Didn't look closely enough at the calendar. Two weeks before the BBQ, I went to the Reno VA hospital to meet with all the personnel involved in putting on a function like this. We discussed all the new protocols, and that led to the menu and who was paying for who and what. I shared my plan for the menu with them, and they all were OK with it. Keep in mind that this hospital has been closed down for three years due to Covid 19.

All the vendors (groups such as the Auburn Elks) had dropped out of sight. I was informed that our Elks Lodge was the only group that kept in touch with the hospital throughout this entire saga. It was determined that the hospital would pay for the food I requested for the patients while it was my responsibility to pay for the food for the staff and volunteers. I planned for about 90-100 people. The hospital fed about 65 patients while we cooked for about 30 staff and volunteers. With all the glitches that occurred and working through their new protocols, I consider this BBQ to be a resounding success. It took us a couple of hours longer to complete this cookout. We'll work out the kinks and streamline the process better for the next time. We cooked hamburgers and hot dogs; provided macaroni and potato salad, chips, soda, and chocolate cake.

All this work was accomplished with four volunteers, Bryan Johnson and his wife Diane, along with me and my wife, Patty. It was a challenge, and we all stepped up and completed this event with everyone extremely satisfied, both the patients and the staff. As I said earlier, this was their first dining event since Covid shut them down. While there, we donated nine lap blankets for the patients. In August, some of our Lodge members will return to Reno for a repeat performance. I think we'll be just fine. At our next Lodge meeting, I will report to the floor the event's particulars, including the cost. The Lodge Veterans Fund paid for this BBQ.

Significant dates to remember from June included June 6th, 1944, D-Day, Operation Overlord, Allied forces invade Normandy; June 14th, 1775, Flag Day, the Continental Army established (Birthday of the U.S. Army and Infantry Branch); June 18th is Father's Day; June 20th, 1941, the Army Air Corps becomes the Army Air Forces; June 21st, is the first day of Summer; June 23rd, 1865, the last Confederate forces surrender; June 24th, 1948, the Berlin Airlift begins; June 25th, 1876, the Battle of Little Bighorn begins; June 25th, 1950, the Korean War begins; June 26th, 1876, the Battle of Little Bighorn ends.

As I wind up this article, I'm always reminded of our collective health. Check on your older friends and relatives and see how they are doing. Some of us have family or friends proudly serving in our military somewhere around the world. Pray for all those people who may need your prayers. Until we meet again, keep smiling and move forward.





## Life Members

According to the By-Laws, which has not changed in many years, the amount due for life membership has been calculated incorrectly. Below is the section in the By-laws dealing with life membership dues:

### (c) LIFE MEMBERSHIP

**In addition** to the amounts set forth under (a) above, each Life Member and/or Honorary Life Member shall pay **\$60.00** towards Lodge administration expense.

### (a) PER CAPITAS

On or before April 1st of each year, **all Members, including Life Members**, shall pay the Grand Lodge per capita fee, Grand Lodge per capita insurance assessment, and State Association dues, **in addition** to the appropriate **regular or Life Member dues** as specified in the remainder of this Section.

This means that next year the membership dues for a life member will be \$60 plus the per capita, which is currently \$40 **Making the total amount dues to \$100.00 for a life member next year.**
